Celebration of India's 78th Independence Day

In the evening, several iconic monuments in Mexico City including Angel de la Independencia, Government buildings in Zocalo, Monumento a la Revolucion and Fuente de Petroleos were illuminated in the Indian tricolor by the Government of Mexico city, symbolizing the enduring friendship between India and Mexico.
